PROJECTEXPLORER.ORG'S MEXICO FILM SERIES DEBUTS

Films Encourage Greater Understanding of America's Geographic & Cultural Neighbor

September 25, New York, NY - Beginning September 27, 2010, students the world over have the opportunity to experience the rich cultural and historic landscape of the nation of México via ProjectExplorer.org's *Mucho México* film and multimedia series.

The fourth series from award-winning educational film company ProjectExplorer.org, *Mucho México* features more than 50 short films and accompanying multimedia. The series serves as a gateway for students to explore and discuss topics as varied as: archaeology, religion, traditional cuisine, government and politics, astronomy and physics, and arts and culture.

Videos on the site provide an in depth look at the México often overlooked. "Putting México's History in Context" is a six-minute video that spans nearly 4000 years of the nation's development; while exploration of the works of Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera provide a glimpse into México's political and cultural past through the impassioned eyes of two revolutionary artists.

Notable features and topics in the series include an extensive history of Spanish influence on México's national development, the origins of the cacao bean and its migration to Europe, and the mysteries surrounding the archaeological site of Teotihuacán. Moving into contemporary México, the series addresses controversial border issues and the nation's many political and economic changes through time.

Series Director and Producer Jenny M. Buccos hopes "this new series will shed light a country that is typically associated with negative media coverage. Too often lost behind the shroud of political controversy, the nation of México offers a rich and incredible history that has led to today's vibrant culture."
